

Jezebel is the easygoing sister to Willful Wine Co. The Jezebel wines are produced with the intent of providing wine that is well-balanced and interesting and designed for immediate consumption.

The 2018 Pinot Noir is a blend of fruit from vineyards the Willamette Valley (58%) and Southern Oregon (Umpqua Valley, 42%). The fruit was cropped around two to three tons per acre, carefully tended by hand and fermented in small lots with a variety of yeasts that were chosen to bring out the fullest expression of the fruit and create a wine that will be pleasurable to drink young. The finished blend is a wine that is fruit-forward and well balanced: enjoyable with a variety of foods, or in a glass all by itself.

2018 was a typically "Oregonian" vintage. The wine has bright red fruit flavors, medium weight, supple texture and an easy to drink appeal. It's very versatile with food and pairs especially well with roast chicken and pork.
