The 2021 Pinot noir is a blend of Dijon, Wädenswil and Pommard clones from vineyards in the Chehalem Mountains, Dundee Hills, Eola-Amity, Ribbon Ridge and Yamhill-Carlton AVAs. The wine has rich dark berry flavors with some spice notes, graceful tannins and balanced acidity. It will pair well with the usual Pinot noir partners: salmon, mushrooms and chicken.

Aged in 100% French oak for 11 months. Mostly neutral wine some new and some once and twice-filled barrels.
