The wine has pretty fruit, medium weight and balanced acidity. It will pair well with the usual pinot noir partners: salmon, mushrooms and chicken.

The 2018 Willamette Valley Pinot Noir is a blend of Pommard clone Pinot Noir from Northridge Vineyard, Eola-Amity Hills (33%), Pommard, Wadenswil and 777 from Stewart Vineyard in Ribbon Ridge (42%) and old vine 115 Pinot Noir from Hoy Vineyard in the Chehalem Mountain AVA (25%)

The grapes were fermented in small lots using native yeasts with around 40% whole cluster. The wine was aged for twelve months in French oak (some neutral and several one-year-old barrels).

This wine has plumy red fruit flavors paired with a soft, elegant texture and earthy, floral aromas. It will pair well with chicken, pork or salmon. Drink now or cellar for five or more years.
